Parking Overflow

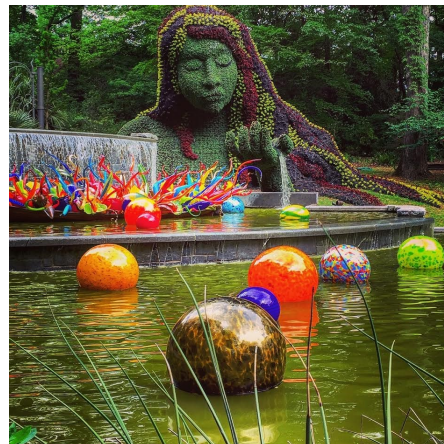
There has been some parking congestion on the front campus Lot A closest to the Taylor Amphitheater.

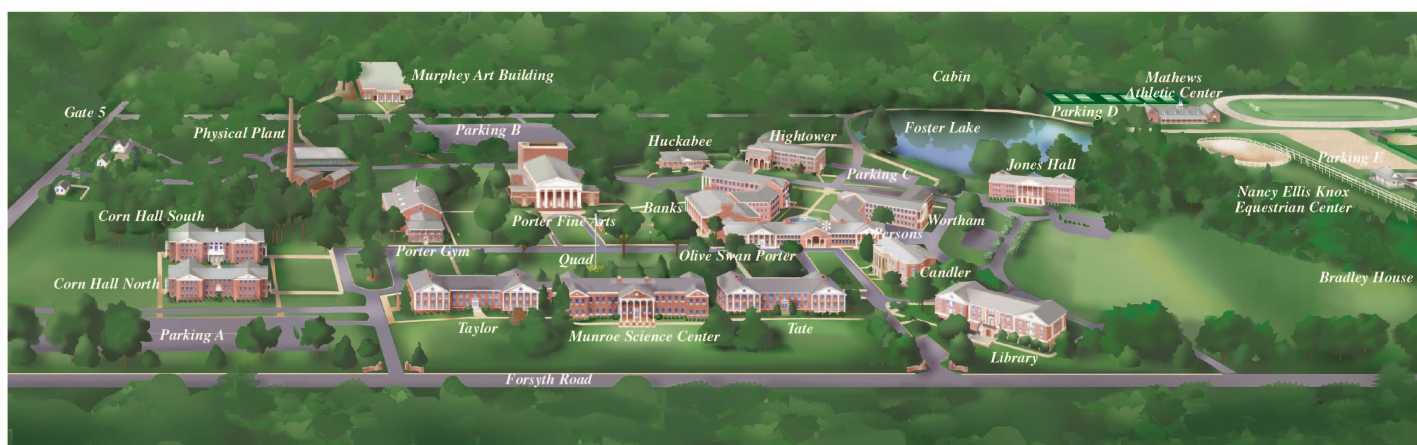

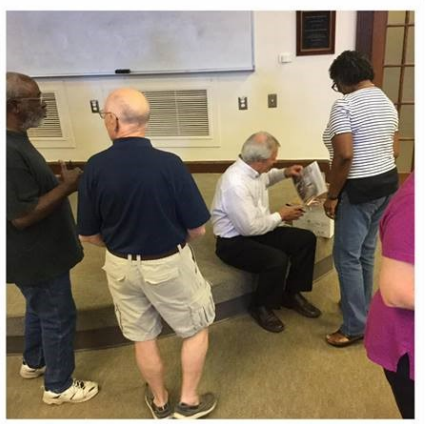
