

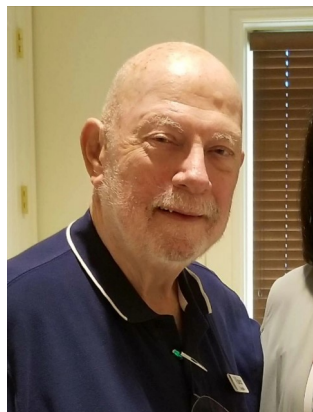

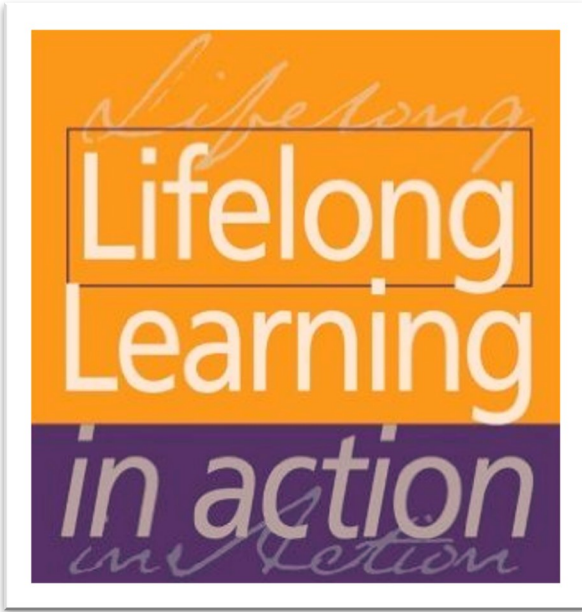

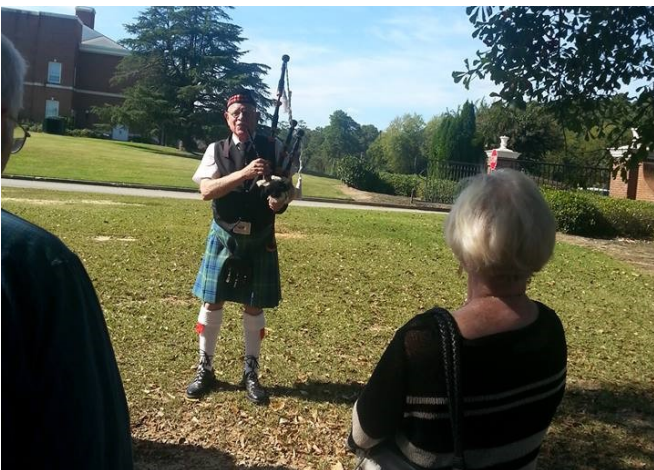

**Music can usually be heard during a WALL semester. These students learn about the Highland Bagpipe in a previous course**

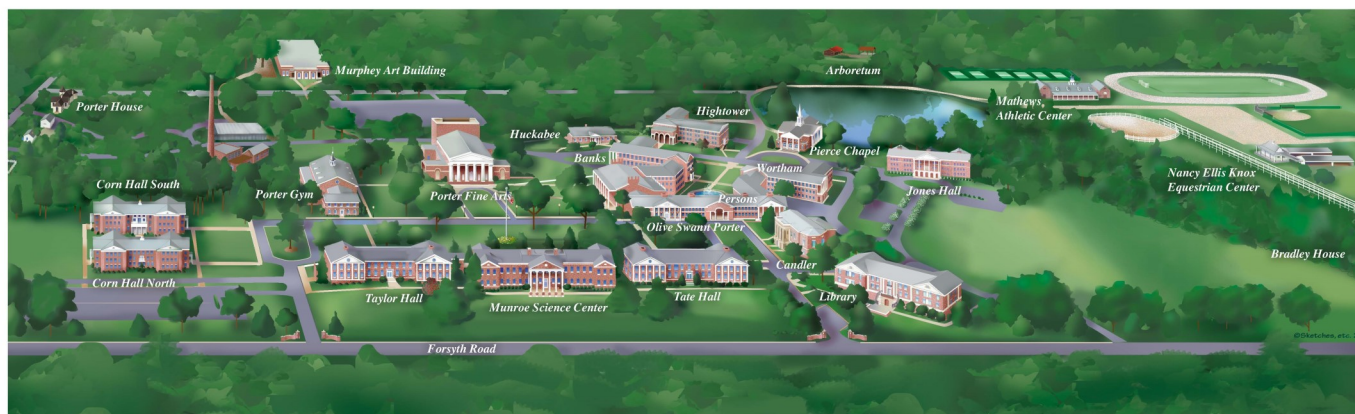
